

### **Q: WHEN DOES REGISTRATION OPEN FOR SUMMER CAMP 2026?**

BCA Summer Camp registration will open on Wednesday, February 4, 2026 at 12pm. Starting the week of January 12, a digital version of our catalog will be available online for browsing.

### **Q: HOW DO I REGISTER FOR SUMMER CAMPS?**

To register, visit [burlingtoncityarts.org](http://burlingtoncityarts.org). Full payment is required to secure a space. Act fast! Your shopping cart will hold a space for 15 minutes while you complete the registration.

### **Q: HOW DO I APPLY FOR A SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIP?**

Scholarship applications should be submitted between January 14-25. Scholarships submitted after January 25 will be reviewed on a rolling basis and subject to camp availability at that time.

The demand for scholarship funds has greatly increased and we're committed to spreading available funds among as many applicants as possible. We may not be able to award multiple scholarships to an individual throughout the year. When able, we encourage applicants to contribute to their class fees, so more people can benefit from BCA scholarships.

### **Q: WHAT LOGIN DO I USE TO REGISTER?**

The City of Burlington uses CivicRec as a platform for registration for two city departments: Burlington City Arts and Parks, Recreation, and Waterfront. If you've recently registered for a program with either department, you will use the same account and login information for both.

If you haven't registered with us in a while, please [create an account](#) in advance. Be sure to add all children, with their date of birth, to your household account. The system will recognize program eligibility based on age.

When logging in, be sure to use the green 'Login with Email' button, regardless of your email provider (such as Gmail), using one of the other buttons may lead to the creation of a duplicative account.

### **Q: WHAT ARE BCA'S CAMP HOURS?**

BCA's camp schedule is developed for flexibility! BCA now offers a full-day camp option for ages 6-8 and 9-11, which runs from 8 am-3pm. Each full-day session combines two complementary half-day camps with a one-hour supervised lunch break in between. At registration, you will select from the Full-Day Camps drop-down for your child's age group.

We continue to offer half-day camps for ages 6-17, which run in the morning from 8-11 am and afternoon from 12-3 pm. At registration, you will select from the Half-Day Camps drop down. Participants ages 12-17 can continue to pair two camps together to build a full-day of coverage with permission to travel off-site at a lunch break or by purchasing lunch coverage for an additional fee at registration.

Aftercare is available from 3-5 pm as an extended coverage add-on for campers ages 6-11 who participate in either a full-day or afternoon half-day camp.

### **Q: IF I JOIN A WAITLIST, WHEN AND HOW WILL I BE NOTIFIED?**

BCA camps may fill quickly! If your desired camp fills up, we encourage you to join the waitlist. Once a spot becomes available, you will be sent a notification via email with a unique link to register. This link will stay active for 24 hours. Once that time has lapsed, we will notify the next name on the waitlist.

To check your waitlist status, please login to your CivicRec account, and navigate to the sidebar menu, under Wait List Status. This will reflect active waitlists for all members of your household and their current position in the queue.
