- 1. Nominating Update

  - c. Bylaws will be revised to reflect changes at May 17<sup>th</sup> meeting, and the new application packet will be publicized after that.
- 2. Special Classes of the Board
  - a. Language acknowledging two special classes of members and their voting rights, Emeritus and Honorary, need to be incorporated into the By-Laws. The board voted on these special classes in the past but voted for Emeritus to be voting and honorary to be non-voting; the preference is for Honorary to be voting and Emeritus to be non-voting, in line with general understandings of Emeritus.
- 3. Mission Statement Update
  - a. No major changes to content are planned for the revision of the statement. The staff is interested in updated the language to be more contemporary. Because the mission is and will remain so broad, we are developing a set of guiding principles that will help staff set work plan priorities on an ongoing basis.
  - b. The language will remove the term "Greater Burlington".
  - c. A draft of the language will be sent to the board in advance of our next meeting.
